

What you should know before you connect

IT Services offers both a public and a secure wireless service. It is highly recommended to use the secure wireless network as it uses encryption to protect your private information such as online accounts and sites where you might provide personal information.

UFV wireless network supports devices with wireless capability. If your existing device does not have wireless capability built-in, IT Services recommends using a Wi-Fi wireless network card supporting **802.1x with WAP** (Wi-Fi Protected Access). UFV wireless network supports cards from **802.11g down to 802.11b**.

Install and connect your wireless network card using the manufacturer's instructions. IT Services recommends using the *Windows* wireless management software instead of the manufacturer's software utility to manage your card.

Setup your access to UFV wireless and secure your connection

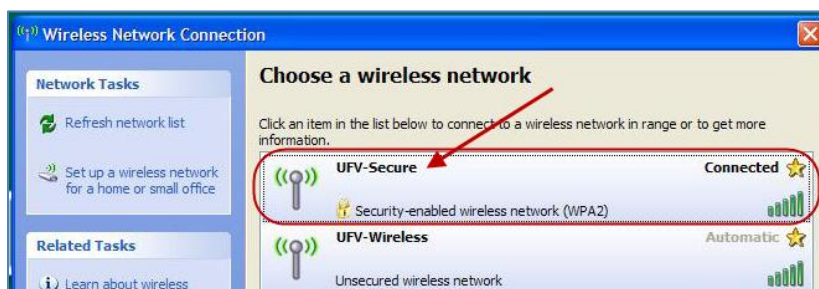
1. Right-click on the **Wireless Network Connection** icon in your **Windows System Tray** (usually located in the bottom right corner near to the clock).



2. Choose **View Available Wireless Networks** from the menu.



3. Choose a wireless network from the **Wireless Network Connection** page (IT Services recommends you use **UFV-Secure**).

4. Enter the **Network key: UFV.2010** when the **Wireless Network Connection** page appears.



5. Open **Internet Explorer** to be automatically redirected to the **UFV Wireless access** login page.
6. Click **Yes** to any security alert messages, and then click **Continue**.
7. Log in and authenticate to the network:
 - a. **Students** log in using their student number and password
 - b. **Employees** log in using their network username and password

Additional Help

- **Authentication:** If your "Username and password is not found" when you attempt to log in, please first log in to a UFV campus computer to synchronize your accounts.
- **Internet proxy settings:** Check your internet browser is set to auto-discover or direct-connect.
- **Static TCP/IP settings:** Copy your TCP/IP settings and choose to "Set to obtain addresses automatically".
- **Where can I find a UFV computer lab?** UFV Library computers may be available if drop-in labs are closed.
- **Where can I wireless assistance?** IT Services Help Desk in Abbotsford B243 can assist with your wireless account.
