You can use your TOEFL, IELTS, LPI, CAEL, CPT (UFV Composition Placement Test) scores, or your high school English or Communications courses to meet academic program language requirements or to begin the University Foundation Certificate Program (Advanced and Bridge Levels of ESL / Intermediate and Advanced Levels of UUP) at UFV.

If you have a TOEFL, IELTS, LPI, CAEL, or CPT score that meets the requirements listed above, please ensure that an official copy of your results is sent to us by October 29, 2009 for the Winter 2010 semester. UFV’s TOEFL code is 9736. Please note that for IELTS results, a copy of the official score is acceptable. For internet-based TOEFL scores (iBT), please send UFV your TOEFL username and password and UFV will verify your score online.

Students who do not have official TOEFL, IELTS, LPI, CAEL, or CPT scores will write a UFV English Language Assessment on arrival and will be registered into ESL credit courses appropriate to their English skill levels. [Students who place at a beginner level of English (below IELTS 3.0 or TOEFL iBT 30) will be given the option of non-credit tutoring, as beginner level instruction is not offered within the UFV ESL program.]

Please note that students who write the English Language Assessment on arrival are not guaranteed access to academic courses, as access is dependent on evidence of English proficiency and seat availability. Students with transfer credit for previous university-level English courses will not be required to write the English Language Assessment.
