

## English and Math Assessment Information for New International Students

We encourage new students to submit language score reports (TOEFL, IELTS, etc.) prior to arrival, as this provides program and course certainty for students. The English Language Assessment (ELA) and math assessments are made available for students who have been unable to submit scores or evidence of math proficiency.

If you are scheduled to write the ELA and/or math assessment on arrival, please use the online resources listed below to help you prepare. Students who have been conditionally accepted to a program pending evidence of math proficiency are required to write a math assessment.

Final course selection and program designation will be dependent on the ELA results and math assessment (if needed).

Most English and Math placement tests are done using Accuplacer (<http://www.collegeboard.com/student/testing/accuplacer/index.html>). Accuplacer is a computer adaptive test used to assess skills in English and mathematics and is used at hundreds of North American post-secondary institutions.
