

### What is a Search Box Widget?

Many database vendors have created "cut and paste" code which can be added to a web-page, creating a search box targeting their databases. You may set up single or multiple targets from each vendor. For example, you may wish to have students search a combination of Criminal Justice Abstracts and NCJRS. These search boxes work well within Blackboard courses.

### Why would I include this on a course page in Blackboard?

If your course involves some type of research assignment, you can recommend and direct students to one or more databases relevant to their topic. The search box widgets bring the databases to "where the students" are, rather than having to negotiate through the library's pages. Instructions are available at:
