Many of our programs "ladder" into one another, allowing you to keep your options open by earning a one-year certificate and/or a two-year diploma on the way to completing a full degree. You can also get started on professional careers like medicine, law, veterinary medicine, engineering, accounting, or physiotherapy. Many of our programs offer a co-operative education option, where you can combine study with supervised, professional, paid, work experience. Our international programming makes for a culturally diverse student body and great opportunities to study abroad.
