ESSAY ASSIGNMENT:

This paper will be a traditional research essay on a subject chosen in consultation with the instructor. The length will be 10 pages, typed. A bibliography of at least ten entries is required.

An outline must be submitted for approval before research is begun.

The initialed outline is resubmitted with the paper.

Essays on topics not approved will not be accepted.

At least one third of each essay must be personal opinion based on the facts found during the research.

Essays will be accepted during the week after the deadline but with a late penalty attached of 5% per day.

The course text is **not** to be cited as a source in the research assignment.
