What does Step By Step Do?

Step By Step Child Development Society originally started in 1979 and was run totally by dedicated volunteers. In 1980, a grant was received to assist in the running, and expansion, of the program. In August of 1981, Step By Step was registered as a non-profit, charitable organization, to provide services for preschool children who had one or more medical needs, behaviour challenges, or were at risk for developmental delay due to social/economic/environmental issues.

At Step By Step we believe in family centred care and that *a child is a child first*.



Services & Programs

Step Together Learning Centre at Harbour View Elementary School

In Coquitlam, for children aged three to twelve (3-12) years, strongly supporting the concept of an enriched preschool/daycare/out of school care environment, with a strong family centred approach

Equipment & Toy Loans Cupboard

Our equipment cupboard provides therapeutic equipment to enrich the day to day lives of children and further develop their large and small muscles, further enabling children to fully participate in community programs.

Equipment can be used at home or in community programs.

Therapeutic Intervention Program

This program is targeted for children that may not have had an opportunity to be exposed to early intervention services prior to entering Kindergarten.

With the expertise of a multi-disciplinary team of a Pediatric Physiotherapist, a Pediatric Occupational Therapist and an Child Development Specialist, your child will develop the skills that will ensure a smooth transition into Kindergarten.

The program is designed specifically for children, it is a sensorial play based learning and playing environment. Through this sensorial approach, the children will be encouraged to learn the skills necessary to enter into Kindergarten in their individual learning style. The Therapeutic Intervention Program is implemented in various schools throughout the Tri-Cities area.

Family Network & Resource Room at Harbour View Elementary School
