### Board of Governors

The management, administration and control of the property, revenue, business and affairs of the University are vested in the Board. The Board functions under the authority of the *University Act*.

Normally, the Board meets 10 times per year, generally on the first Thursday of the month (with one or two exceptions) beginning at 4:00 pm and ending at approximately 9:30 pm. The meetings are held on a rotational basis at all five UFV campuses (Abbotsford, Mission, Chilliwack, Hope and/or Agassiz). In addition, most Board members serve on a Board committee and attend an annual one/two day Board retreat.

Generally, Board members should expect to contribute an average of 15-20 hours per month to the University. ### Senate

Senate is the academic governing body at UFV which is responsible for policies concerning academic matters and advising the Board on policies of mutual interest. Senate business is conducted through its standing committees, whose terms of reference are posted on the Senate website at <http://www.ufv.ca/senate.htm>.

The Senate meets once each month at 1 pm on Friday of the second week in the UFV meeting schedule. Meetings alternate between UFV campuses. Senate members are expected to represent the Senate on at least one Senate sub-committee.
