POLICY

Convocation of the University of the Fraser Valley will confer the appropriate graduation award upon receiving the list of graduands from the Senate.

PROCEDURES/GUIDELINES

1. The Registrar will determine, in consultation with the departments, which students have met the diploma, certificate, associate degree, and baccalaureate degree requirements. The Registrar will obtain a list of graduate degree graduands after it has been approved by the Graduate Studies Committee and the Associate Vice-President, Research and Graduate Studies.
2. The Registrar will provide the Senate with a list of proposed graduands.
3. The Senate will approve the list of proposed graduands.
4. The Registrar is granted the authority to correct/amend the list of graduands under the exceptional or extenuating circumstances upon the recommendation of the department, or the Associate Vice-President, Research and Graduate Studies for graduate degrees, and the approval of the Senate Chair and Vice-Chair.
5. Departments will advise their students if they are not approved as graduands.
6. The Senate will establish a final appeal tribunal for students who wish to appeal.
