

Blackboard/myUFV & Single Sign-on

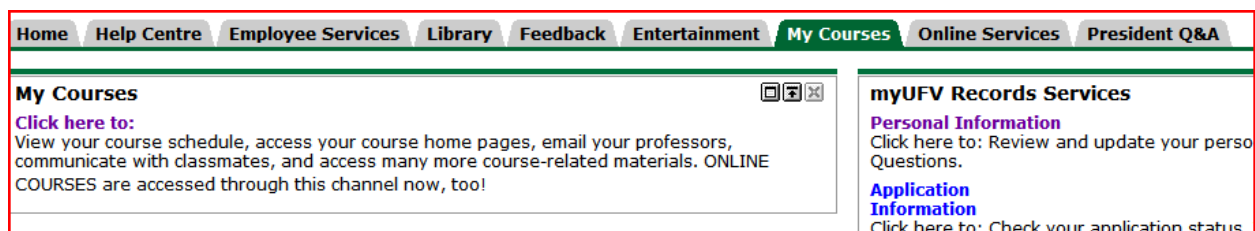
Single sign-on into your online courses is now available from myUFV. What does this mean for you and your students?

When your students log into myUFV they can now select their course from the My Courses Tab and if it has a Blackboard component, they will go directly into the course without having to log in again.

There is a step you, as the instructor, will have to make for each course that will have a Blackboard component. That step is to tell myUFV that the Blackboard course is there.

To make this change:

- Log into myUFV and click the My Courses tab.
- Click on the link on the left “Click here to:”



- At the immediate left of the course name, click on the edit icon (Demonstration course in Figure 1)

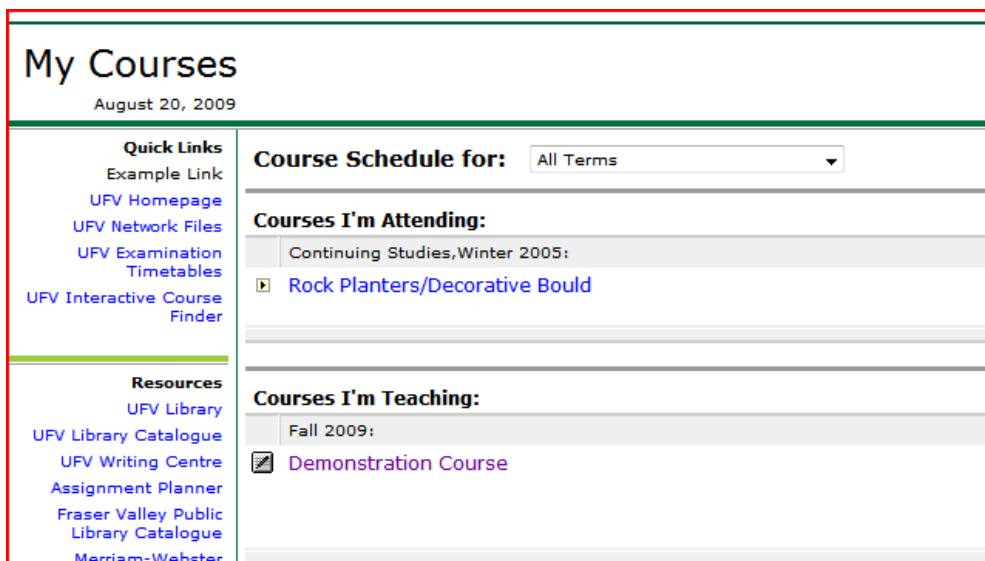


From this window select WebCT (Blackboard)

Click on the Save Changes button.

Choose to setup a blank course or select the content from a course from a previous term or development course.

Once the content has been assigned (or if it already had been assigned) you will return to the My Courses list (figure 1) in myUFV and your students will have Single sign-on access to your online course.

NOTE: If you do not have content in your course the students will be directed to login to the main Blackboard system.
