How to Spend your Leave in Manchester

Members of H.M. Forces from Overseas and Service members of the Allied Nations should obtain a copy of the Manchester Weekly Guide issued free by the Y.M.C.A. Information Bureau and available at Service Centres

An official booklet issued by the Manchester and Salford War Hospitality Committee is also available free on request. This booklet gives detailed information regarding places of worship, libraries, art galleries and museums. The Weekly Guide offers suggestions for entertainment and recreation for each day of the week.

Manchester is famous as a centre of the Lancashire Textile Industry and parties of Servicemen are conducted each week over a modern textile mill within a short bus journey of the city.

The Manchester Ship Canal links Manchester with the sea and allows big cargoes to be unloaded in the Manchester Docks. By permission of the Directors of the Manchester Ship Canal Company a weekly visit is arranged to Barton Bridge in one of the Company's steamers. At Barton the Bridgewater Canal is carried over the Ship Canal.

Other popular tours include visits to Electrical Engineering and Armament Works, a Cigarette and Tobacco Factory, a Daily Newspaper Office and a Modern Soap Works.

Admission at reduced prices, and, in some cases, free seats are available to places of Entertainment by kind permission of Proprietors.

The Map of Central Manchester printed overleaf, together with the Reference key on the back page, indicates where Hostel or Club accommodation is available. Bed reservations should be made as early as possible each day.
