CALENDAR DESCRIPTION:

[This description not to be printed in calendar — for information purposes only.] This credit course enables students with previous experience in Sculpture to work under the supervision of the instructor and develop personal initiatives using the studio equipment facilities. The student/instructor relationship is more informal than traditional, the instructor serving as a tutorial resource (both technical and conceptual). The students exercise their independence from the ongoing structured class, but are welcome to participate in demonstrations, discussions and projects as is their need. Student objectives and assignments are to be determined through consultation with the instructor. Applicants go through an interview process. Applicants will be interviewed and the objectives and assignments determined prior to registration.
