CALENDAR DESCRIPTION:

A three session segment offered by a career counsellor exploring educational and employment options. Students will be introduced to the resources available for career planning and develop an action plan for further research.

RATIONALE:

Following up on a fairly extensive vocational and academic assessment, students will now require guidance in the steps towards developing a plan for further career investigation. Students attracted into this type of program are not the self-starters who are able to have a one-hour session with a UCFV counsellor and procede on their own initiative. This, and several courses in the certificate program, are designed to walk the students through the steps at their pace.
