CALENDAR DESCRIPTION:

This course offers the opportunity to investigate a variety of careers by speaking directly to the people who are in the jobs students are seeking. Students will select the careers and the speakers will be invited into the class to describe the jobs and skills required and respond to student questions.

RATIONALE:

While many programs dealing with career training incorporate a similar segment, asking students to interview people in the career they are investigating, students who consulted on the set-up of this program were adamant that such an assignment is too intimidating. Students able to carry out this assignment may already have many of the skills being taught in this program. Inviting the speakers into the classroom is less intimidating, yet offers the same core effect of acquainting students with all the details and requirements of a specific job.
