CALENDAR DESCRIPTION:
 A practical second course in statistics, using statistical software packages, that applies statistical principles to problems in economics and business.
 The course includes an overview of sampling techniques to aid market research, an introduction to multiple regression and time series analysis with an emphasis on forecasting, decision theory and the construction of price indices. All students are expected to complete a project applying at least one of the course techniques to a real dataset.
 Note: This course is offered as BUS 301 and ECON 301. Students may take only one of these for credit.
