This course explores the evolution and diversity of theatre and drama from Antiquity to 1642. It investigates the development and significance of a range of theatre forms and dramatic genres from different historical periods, which might include Greek tragedy, Roman comedy, Sanskrit theatre, Medieval drama, Japanese Noh, and Elizabethan tragedy and comedy. This course may involve field trips to see plays in the Lower Mainland. Note: Students with credit for THEA 202 may not take THEA 203/ENGL 233 for further credit. Note: This course is offered as THEA 203 and ENGL 233. Students may take only one of these for credit.
