

Academic Advising

Educational Planning	Advisors connect students to the UFV community and teach them to link program requirements, courses, administrative procedures, and transfer policies to maximize their options and ensure their greatest chance of success. Educational planning is done with special consideration to each student's abilities, values, lifestyle and finances.
Research	Advisors teach students how to research and explore educational opportunities at UFV and other institutions.
Information Gathering	Advisors provide students with information about UFV courses, programs, services and resources to help students make informed decisions.
Advocacy	Advisors represent student interest on UFV committees and assist departments in making educational programs, policies and procedures.
Referrals	Advisors refer students to UFV support services and departments, community resources and other institutions as needed.
Instruction	Advisors design and deliver workshops related to advising topics and work with students on an individual basis.
Listening	Advisors offer a safe listening environment and impartial educational advice to students.

Advisors work with students during 60-minute booked appointments, drop-in sessions, virtual meetings, through email or by phone.
