

Eriophyllum lanatum




Community Garden:

- -Increases presence of pollinators
- -Graphs below show positive correlation between number of flowering species and pollinator species that visit the area



Recommendations:

- -Install a fence nested area providing protection from human disturbance and predators
- -Install signage encouraging humans to not disturb the area and prevent dumping of Redeared Slider turtles -Install and anchor logs offshore, to provide basking sites








- **Recommendation to** decrease human impacts on species/park:
 - -Decrease litter by adding more garbage/recycling bins near the parks
 - -Educational signs to educate visitors on various species and to show visitors what not to do.



Also, uncourage UFV students in a catch and release program to estimate the Western Painted Turtle population, which removing Red-eared Sliders from the lake
