Applicants to the Bachelor of Media Arts degree are assessed for eligibility based on two submissions:

<p>Portfolio</p> <p>NOTE: Applicants who have completed a diploma from the Vancouver Film School do not need to submit a portfolio.</p>	<p>A portfolio is an opportunity for you to showcase your best work, created in various media, that reflects your talent, knowledge, interest, skills, and creative development.</p> <p>We encourage you to include a range of examples, including a variety of subject matter, techniques, forms or genres, and concepts. Please include 8-10 pieces of work relevant to the degree, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Digital design • Interactive media • Traditional fine art work • Performance or performance-related documents (screenplays, script) • Digital art • Other forms of creative production or writing <p>Examples of acceptable formats include PDF, JPEG, PNG, or TIFF formats URL link to a specific work (video)</p>
<p>Letter of Interest</p> <p>Your letter should be no more than two pages in length, single-spaced, in 12 point font, with 2.5 cm margins.</p>	<p>Your letter of interest should communicate why you are interested in the Bachelor of Media Arts degree, what you hope to learn in the program, and how the BMA will help you achieve your career goals. Your letter should answer the following questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Why are you choosing the Bachelor of Media Arts program at UFV? • Who or what inspires you? • How have your academic or work experience prepared you for the Bachelor of Media Arts program? • What concentration are you most interested in? • What are your career goals?
