The transition to adulthood can be a challenge for anyone. If you are between 15 and 19 years of age and in continuing care, *Kinnections* can help you identify someone who has been involved in your life that may be in a position to act as your mentor. Where this is not possible, *Kinnections* can connect you with a supportive volunteer mentor who can help guide you – or just be there if you need someone to talk to. **For more information about *Kinnections*, talk to your guardianship social worker.**
