Please follow these guidelines below if you would like me to read your work before our meeting:

- Please send work a week in advance if you'd like me to read it ahead of our meeting
- No more than 10 pages per submission. Feel free to send a 10 page excerpt of a longer piece.
- If you're looking for a specific kind of feedback, include 1 or 2 sentences to specify (ie. this is an early draft—no line edits, just overall concept feedback please, etc).
- If submitting multiple pieces, start each piece on a new page

Formatting:

I request specific formatting for a variety of reasons, but mainly because it prepares you for the standard requirements for submitting work to publications.

- Include page numbers
- Include your name in the header or footer
- 12 point font, Times New Roman
- Double-spaced (2.0) for prose or single-spaced (1.0) for poetry (start each poem on a new page)
- Minimum 1 inch margins
- Submit as a Word file: .doc or .docx (PDF for graphic forms)
