Dean's News Update

To FECHD members -

Due to my absence at the December Faculty Council, I offer these news updates:

- 1. The FECHD budget has been submitted. Hopes are high that it is accepted as is. It was a very worthwhile task to consider how our departments respond to the needs of students and the funds that support our efforts.
- I am delighted to announce that the ELS Department's classes will move to UUP with Greg St.
 Hilaire as Head, effective April 1st. This move will also mean a move in offices for the 2 ELS
 faculty from their present location to the UUP offices in B Building, Abbotsford. The move to
 UUP allows the courses to continue while reducing some of the overriding costs of the ELS
 department.
- 3. There is now a working group of heads and directors that are beginning talks about the creation of a School of Education and what that could look like. There are many more conversations to come, but I thought you'd be interested to know that this is one direction FECHD is taking in the organization of our new Faculty. Expect updates as they emerge throughout the Winter term.
- 4. Relatedly, a focus of the Dean's Office in the new year will be the establishment of some shared protocols to make processes at the clerical level clearer for department heads and directors as well as staff and faculty going forward.
- 5. In the new year, I intend to begin some discussions about a strategic plan for FECHD. Perhaps I should say 'FECHD's response to the university strategic plan'. It would be my hope that, together, we could articulate some shared goals and directions and plans that align with the university's mission but highlight the ways our programs can uniquely contribute.

Standing Report Update

- Both UFV Abbotsford and Chilliwack libraries have seen an increase in students coming to the library to study, do research and get assistance from the library teams this term.
- 2. UFV Therapy dogs are back in Abbotsford Library on Mondays or Tuesdays every week for an hour.
- 3. New PODS have been installed in the library space. Two in Chilliwack and soon to be three in Abbotsford. These spaces allow students to study, attend online classes, or Zoom meetings without needing to book the larger study rooms.
- 4. Department library budgets need to be spent down by the end of December, so departments are being encouraged to connect with their liaison librarian to make purchases.
- 5. OpenAthens, UFV Library new authentication system.

A friendly reminder that any existing links to library resources (e.g., articles, videos, and eBooks) that are embedded in Blackboard courses, syllabi, or other course materials will no longer be functional as of Dec. 21st, 2022.

Faculty can submit their <u>Course Reading List forms</u> so that the library team can work on updating those links. Faculty may also update links themselves using our <u>OpenAthens LinksGenerator</u>.
