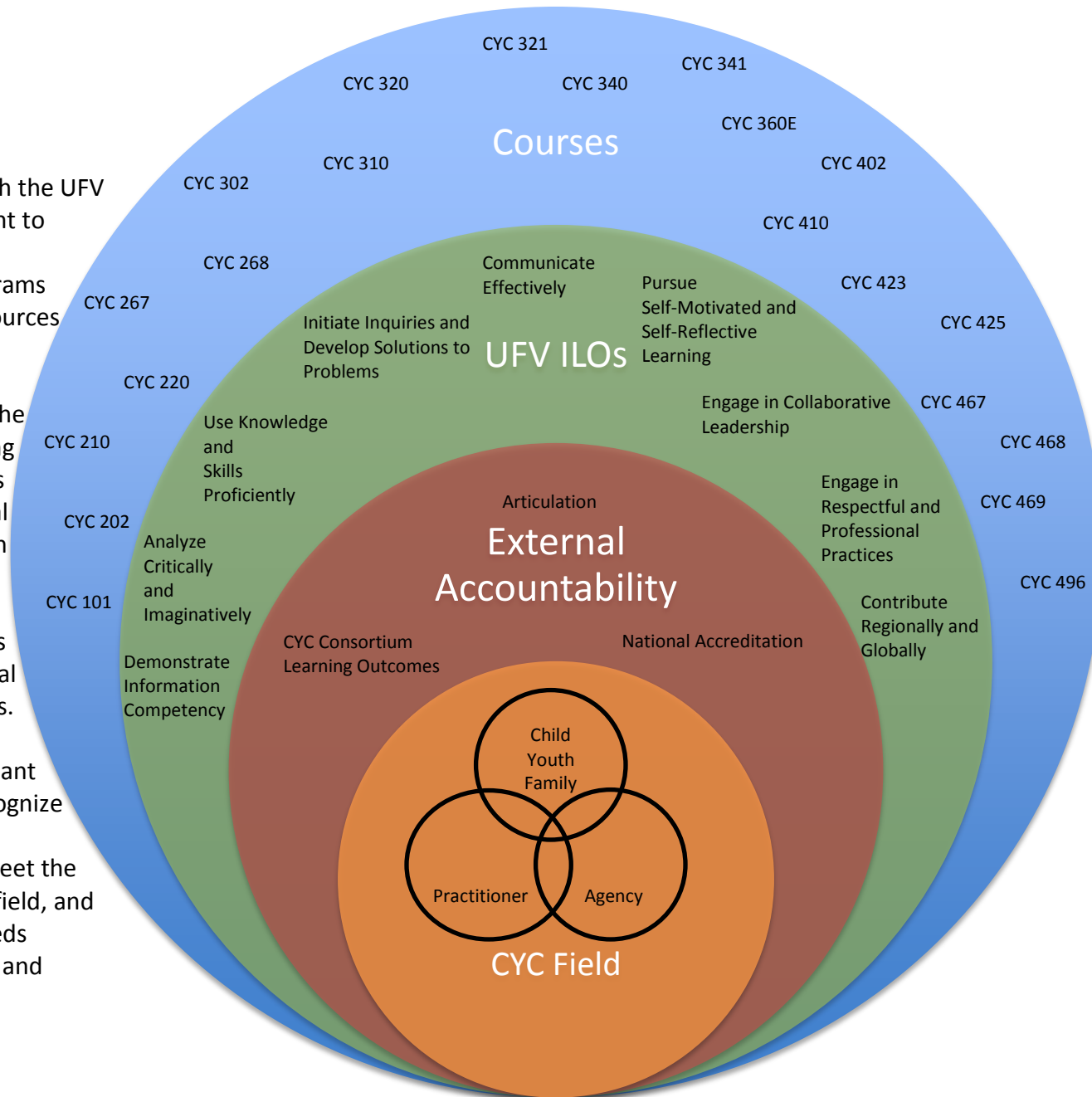


THE CONTEXT OF INSTITUTIONAL LEARNING OUTCOMES ALIGNMENT FOR CYC
