### Terms of Advance (employee/non-employee)

#### Employee Advance

I understand that if my employment terminates prior to repayment of the advance in full, the advance balance due at the time of termination will be deducted from my final wages and any vacation pay due and owing at the time of my termination. If all unpaid earnings at the time of termination are insufficient to settle the advance, I will make a personal payment or sign a promissory note to the University of the Fraser Valley (UFV) for the balance due.
