- Have you **completely** filled out this application?
- Have you included a **typed summary of Grade 10 to 12 accomplishments** including hours per event?
 - Leadership positions: indicate what grade you were in and hours of service. *e.g. Student council President, Grade 12, thirty hours*
 - Memberships or other committee involvement: indicate what grade you were in and hours of service. *e.g. Hospital volunteer, Grades 10 and 11, twenty-five hours*
 - Honours and awards attained: indicate what grade you were in when you received the honour/award. *e.g. Drama Award winner, Grade 11; Athletic Award winner, Grade 12*
 - After school or summer employment: indicate duration *e.g. Newspaper route, daily*
- Have you included a 1-2 page **cover letter** identifying goals, accomplishments, and educational plans?
- Have you included **2 letters of recommendation**?
 - These letters should detail your service and/or leadership activities within the school or community.
- Have you included a **copy of your most current transcript**? A transcript displaying grade 11 and 12 grades must be included in your application package
- Have you read the criteria for the scholarship you are applying for and included any **additional documentation that may be required**?
- Put together one **complete application package** with all supporting documents and letters.

Your English 12 grade **MUST** be in progress (interim grades will be accepted) to be considered for the **President's Entrance Scholarship**.

Application Deadline: **March 10th**

There are 3 ways to submit your application. Your **COMPLETE application package** may be:
