Notes and Terms

Historical numbers in this year's Factbook may differ slightly from previous Factbooks due to (i) changes in data definitions or (ii) retroactive changes made to historical records.

Age: As of September 30th of the Fiscal Year.

Continuing Education (CE): Non-academic and non-trades programs or courses.

Credential "None": A program that does not grant a UFV credential.

Domestic/International: If a student pays international fees for part, or all, of a given Fiscal Year, they are counted as International in that Fiscal Year.

Fiscal Year: Unless otherwise stated, all data is for Fiscal Year, which runs from April 1 to March 31 of the following Calendar Year.

FTE: Full Time Equivalent student. This is calculated as recognized credits (or hours) divided by the appropriate program divisor. FTEs represent UFV's instructional activity converted to represent the number of students carrying a course load corresponding to normal progression in their program. To count for FTE purposes, a student course registration must have passed the stable enrolment date and be considered instructional activity as defined by the Ministry.

Full Time/Part Time (FT/PT): A student is Full Time in a Fiscal Year if the student generates at least 0.6 of an FTE; a student with less than 0.6 but greater than zero FTEs, is Part Time.

Graduate: A student who graduates from a UFV program. A student may be granted multiple credentials in a given year. Students graduate once a year in June and these graduates are attributed to the previous Fiscal Year. For example, June 2019 graduates are attributed to Fiscal Year 2018-19.

Headcount: A student is included in Headcount if the student generates positive FTEs.

Indigenous Student, Self-Declared: Students can self-declare as being Indigenous while studying at UFV. UFV does not require students to declare their status. On their application form, students may elect to self-declare as Aboriginal, First nations, Métis, or Inuit.

New to UFV: A student is New to UFV when the student first generates a positive FTE at UFV in a non-CE term. New to UFV is set only once for each student.

Registration: A single student enrolment in a course that generates any FTEs.

Returning to UFV Student: A student is Returning to UFV if the student has previously generated FTEs at UFV, in a non-CE term.

Unduplicated Headcount: Each student is counted only once; a student is not counted as a member of multiple groups.






Section 9: Research, Engagement, & Graduate Studies

Research is a highly valued scholarly activity that is integrated with teaching and provides significant opportunities for UFV to offer applied learning opportunities for students as research assistants, and the development of community engagement partnerships. Research enables faculty to remain at the cutting edge of their discipline, which they can then bring to the classroom and use it as mentorship opportunities with small groups of students. Partnerships with industry, government and community organizations provide current applied problems to be solved, which provides significant economic and social value to the region. An example of the relevance and nature of applied research were the five new research projects that focused on the economic and social impacts of the Covid-19 pandemic.

In the past year, UFV has added another research centre, the Centre for the Philosophy for Children, bringing the total number of research centres, institutes and labs to eleven. These research entities facilitate interdisciplinary approaches to research questions, the pooling of resources, and the building of capacity that supports the addition of post-doctoral researchers, coordinators, and research associates. Overall, they have been significant contributors to the value of external funding, the numbers of student opportunities, and the breadth of community engagement. The Research Office has added a dedicated staff person to support the administration of the centres, institutes, and labs.


There were 33 new research grants and contracts for a current total of 102 active research projects. In 2020-21, UFV received \$3,552,573 in external research funding, which is the largest amount of external funding in a single year. See Table 1.

Seven of the newly awarded grants came from the Tri-Council Agencies, which includes CIHR and SSHRC, plus another seven NSERC Undergraduate Student Awards. These research grants are the most prestigious awards available to Canadian researchers and the competition is fierce.




14% more student research assistants were hired through the Research Office, resulting in 233 contracts, plus an additional 108 research assistant positions through the Centre for Experiential and Career Education's Work Study Program. Those 341 positions were valued at \$487,203

from a combination of internal and external funding sources. This represents a significant increase over the past five years. See Table 2. In addition, the Research Office provided 49 student research awards totaling another \$89,982.



UFV offered 152 research courses in the past year versus the 101 offered only two years previously and student enrollments in these courses increased to 2,199 students from 1,275 over the same time period. Tracking these enrollments is important as it demonstrates the number of students that are gaining insight into research methods, and a greater understanding of research processes which they can use in their future careers.

The added number and value of research projects has also increased the administrative workload within the Research Office. For example, the Human Research Ethics Board and Compliance Officer had to administer 110 new research protocols and 74 amendments, which is a significant increase over the previous six years. See Table 3.



UFV proudly conferred 53 graduate level credentials in 2020-2021, including 24 Master of Education degrees to the very first cohort of that program. Other graduates were from the Master of Arts in Criminal Justice, graduate certificates in Program Evaluation, Child Life and Community Health, and Mindfulness Based Teaching and Learning. New admissions in graduate programs increased by 10 over 2019-2020 for a total of 78 admissions.




Figure 1: 2019 Carbon emissions by source.




Figure 2: Building emissions per year, and normalized emissions for space and weather fluctuations.
