
The 2021 Survey of Graduating Students was distributed to 51,892 students, resulting in feedback from 15,334 students across Canada from 32 institutions. All results presented for Canada are weighted.




Academic profile of respondents




Demographic profile of respondents




Expectations and experience




Satisfaction with overall quality of education




Feel as if they belong at this university

Study patterns (average hours per week)









Top 3 most important aspects of professors




Top 5 most used facilities and services














