## **ACADEMIC MISCONDUCT APPEAL**

Within 5 business days of the resolution meeting, UFV Policy 70 section 5 allows a student to appeal to a finding of academic misconduct, if they can provide proof the misconduct did not occur, there was procedural bias in the investigation, or the penalty is too severe. Academic Misconduct Appeals are considered only after a student has submitted this form, a copy of the Notice of Disciplinary Action for Academic Misconduct, and tangible supporting evidence.
