You cannot do the next steps without your video/audio ready in Kaltura MyMedia.

If you need to upload or create new video/audio without visiting the Kaltura MyMedia page, please check the step **5b]** below.

This example, from step 3], also applies to the content editor inside other editable areas such as **Discussions, Assignments, Announcements**, etc.

1] In any unit on the left menu, **Create New**. If you already have a page, skip this and next steps and go to step 3].

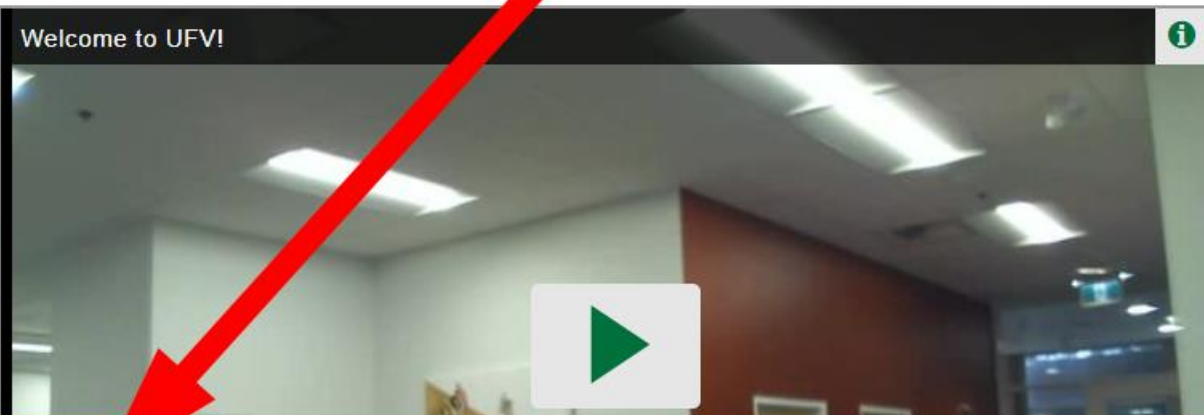

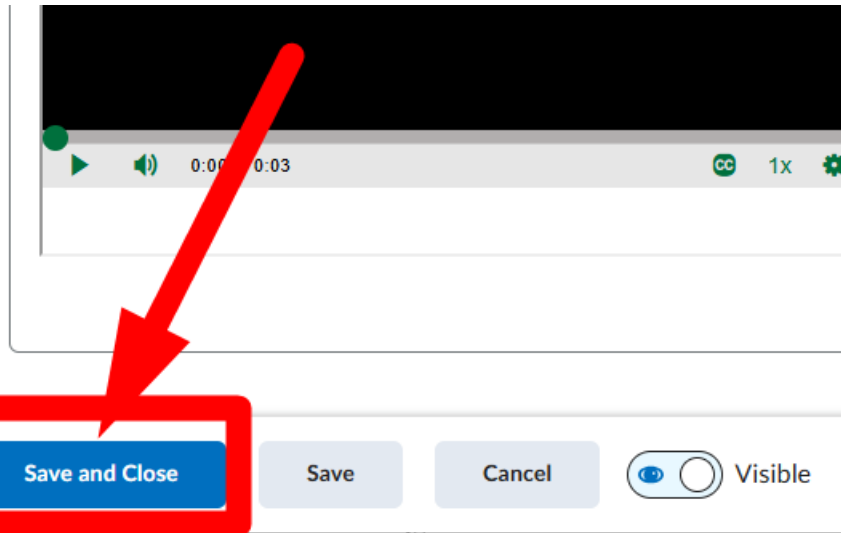
