

Emergency Procedures



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Key Safety Requirements



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Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) must be worn



Housekeeping: keep site clean and safe



Hazard assessments must be updated as conditions change



Use lockout/tagout, confined space entry, and fall protection as required

Site Access and Security



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Access only authorized areas

Ensure proper signage, barricades, and hording are in place

No unauthorized visitors

Maintain security of tools, equipment, and materials

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No smoking/vaping on campus



Prevent spills and control waste



Protect nearby building occupants from noise, dust, and fumes



Follow UFV recycling and hazardous waste protocols
