## **Learning Demonstration Statements**

A learning statement often begins with a fairly short response to the question "what did you do?". Articulating the "how's what's, and why's" further strengthen a learning statement to meet the needs of your assessor (professional body, employer or faculty member).

## Concerning the condition, ask yourself:

How? Where? For what purpose? In relation to what? Why? Under what conditions? To what degree? Why would anyone need to know that?
