

**BOARD OF GOVERNORS POLICY DIRECTION  
ON  
UNIVERSITY PLANNING AND DIRECTIONS**

The University of the Fraser Valley (UFV), as established by the *University Act of British Columbia*, is a Special Purpose, Teaching University mandated to serve the post-secondary educational needs of its region.

In response to government legislation, regulations, and mandate and in considering the breadth of its role as a university, UFV will develop a Mission, Vision, and Values statement for approval by the Board of Governors after seeking the advice and approval of Senate. This statement will define and give direction to UFV in meeting its mandate to serve the current and future post-secondary educational needs of its communities, as well as the values that will guide the university's planning and decision-making.

UFV's strategic goals and plan for achieving them will be consistent with the mission, vision, and values statement.

The University will review and keep current its Mission, Vision, and Values statement and plans. Proposed changes to its statement or Strategic Plan will come to the Board for approval after consultation with and approval from the Senate.

Additional UFV plans, goal setting and decision making will support and be consistent with the approved Mission, Vision, and Values statement and Strategic Plan and Directions.
