2. FPS News

2.1. Department of Child, Youth and Family Studies – *Maple Melder-Crozier*

- Christine Slavik was welcomed back from sabbatical.
- Christine Slavik is presenting for the Chilliwack Human Service Academy partnership with the Chilliwack School District and the Ministry of Children and Family Development on January 13, 2018.
- Cindy Rammage demonstrated the Brain Architecture Game to demonstrate the effects of trauma for the Abbotsford Youth Network.
- Cindy Rammage and Maple Melder-Crozier met with Child and Youth Care Provincial partners over the holidays to continue work on program learning outcomes.
- Maple Melder-Crozier has been invited to a two day meeting in February 2018 at the United Nations Headquarters in New York for discussions about women in education and social responsibility.
- A contract has been signed for a City Studio project.
- CYFS student Jena Kruckenberg and Health Sciences student Mia Harries, who presented on at Faculty Council on September 15, 2017, were featured in <u>UFV Today</u>. The Resource Navigation Program has been implemented at Abbotsford Regional Hospital.

2.2. Department of Library and Information Technology – *Kenneth Gariepy*

- New sessional faculty Ms. Fiona Hunt, who is teaching LIBT 220 on campus and LIBT 140 online, was welcomed.
- The reconstituted LIBIT external program advisory committee will hold its first meeting on February 5, 2018 on the Abbotsford campus. The new members are April Cox, Manager, Surrey City Centre Library; Richard Matiachuk, senior sessional faculty, LIBIT; Sheila Penner, Library Technician, MEI Secondary School; and Heather Scoular, Director of Customer Service Experience, Fraser Valley Regional Library.

2.3. School of Social Work and Human Services – Margaret Coombes

- The Dual Credit initiative with Fraser Cascade, Abbotsford, and Chilliwack School Districts is moving forward and SWHS is accepting 16 high-school students into the Community Support Worker certificate in Fall 2018.
- The Health and Community Service program is expanding in Fall 2018 and will admit an additional 25 high school students.

 UFV and Métis Nation British Columbia (MNBC) received a provincial grant to pilot a two year Métis-specific Community Support Worker program. MNBC has posted a Métis program coordinator position fulltime temporary position. Métis students will begin an upgrading program in Fall 2018 and enter the Community Support Worker classes in Winter 2019.

2.4. Department of Teacher Education – Awneet Sivia

- Awaiting confirmation of the date for the Master of Education in Educational Leadership and Mentorship site review.
- A new international experience opportunity, in addition to the currently offered one in Antigua, has been developed in New Zealand. In May 2018, 6 students will be sent.
