## Five-Year Review – University-Wide Principles for the Establishment and Review of Standards for Tenure and Promotion

The Faculty Standards Committee (FSC) has completed the review of the University-Wide Principles and were approved by Senate at its February 26, 2021 meeting.

#### Background information:

As per the Faculty Standards Committee (FSC) Terms of Reference, the Faculty Standards Committee has the responsibility to advise Senate on matters related to standards for faculty promotion through rank and tenure. FSC responsibilities include recommending university-wide principles for the establishment of criteria for faculty standards and must conduct a review of the university-wide principles at least every five years.

At its October 14, 2020 meeting, the FSC completed the initial work on the 5-year review of the University-Wide Principles. This review began after the FSC had completed its work on the limited reviews of each of the academic units' Standards for Tenure and Promotion. Initial feedback on the University-Wide Principles was requested from each College/Faculty from Dec 2019-Feb 2020. The FSC then conducted an extensive review of the Principles between February 2020 and October 2020. Key changes were noted in the review and included acknowledgement of UFV's commitment to Indigenization, clarifications, and editorial changes.

After FSC completed its work, feedback was requested and received from various stakeholders, including Deans Council, Faculty Councils, and the Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion (EDI) Task Force. The FSC considered all the feedback that was received which resulted in additional revisions and a commitment from FSC to review the Principles against the EDI Lens once it is created.

#### Five-Year Review – Academic Unit Standards for Tenure and Promotion

Each Academic Unit is now expected to review their Standards for Tenure and Promotion and submit a report to the Faculty Standards Committee. The FSC has started to receive submissions:

#### **Physics Standards for Tenure and Promotion**

After the move of the Physics department to the Faculty of Applied and Technical Studies, the Physics department decided to adopt the Faculty of Applied and Technical Studies Standards for Tenure and Promotion. The FSC recommended to Senate for approval and on March 19, 2021, Senate approved with the understanding that Physics will consider the recommendations from the FSC for the upcoming five-year review.

#### **Faculty Service Excellence Award Adjudication**

The FSC is responsible for ensuring membership on the Faculty Service Excellence Award (FSEA) Selection Committee. The FSEA Committee met multiple times to review the adjudication requirements, applications, and procedures. A recommendation for the award and suggested changes to the procedures were then submitted to the Senate Awards and Honours Committee (SAHC) for consideration.
