This planning document includes the addition of positions to support this plan as well as the creation of the position of Si:yam, or 'respected teacher. There was some discussion over the role of a Si:yam, and how it was the responsibility of the grannies to choose who was going to be that person, and to train them from a young age. It was suggested that the role of Sesíwesteleq "respected teacher" might be more appropriate.
