- Banking Update:
 - The meeting with TD did not occur. Due to a miscommunication, the previous SSWA did not confirm their ability to attend in advance, so TD cancelled without notice.
 - 2022 SSWA cannot access the accounts or discuss any related matters with TD until the 2021 co-signers meet with the bank and arrange for a transfer of authority. Melissa remains in Australia, so moving forward is impossible until she returns.

Action Items:

- Must submit funding requests to Student Union with 3-4 weeks' notice. Funding must benefit the entire UFV student body, not just SWHS school. (consider other campuses)
- Introduces students to SSWA committee members and creates awareness of our purpose in supporting UFV students and faculty
- Can we join UFV orientation events for new students?
- Chris & Ashley can begin arranging fundraiser first aid classes for SWHS students:
 - Charge Chris's admin cost (\$25/person) + a donation (normal cost is \$95-110 each) or make it a set price of \$60.00 (provides SSWA \$35/person profit while still saving students \$60/each)?
 - Offer Emergency First Aid with CPR"C" and AED certification
 - Maximum 10 students per session

Creation of a Social Work Student Journaling Group (Shelby, Levi and....)

- Levi will pass along information regarding a psychology journaling group to Shelby to begin creating a framework
- Opting out. Not much interest in the group at this point.

Reaching out to SWHS Instructors before September to connect with students.
