First Day of Class (Face to Face and Hybrid) September 6th

Attend the first class:

Students are also required to attend the first regular meeting of the classes in which they are registered. Students who fail to attend the first regular meeting of a class in which they are registered, and who do not notify the instructor in advance, may be withdrawn from a course, at the discretion of the instructor.

Once classes begin, students must have instructor's permission to register for any course. Students waitlisted and seeking a seat <u>must go to the first class to seek permission</u>.

myUFV Account

myUFV

Activation of student myUFV accounts are done through the Office of the Registrar (OReg). Upon acceptance into UFV, students will receive special access to an Application Portal where they will enter in necessary information to set up the initial connection to their myUFV account. Once set up, students can access things such as:

- □ Applications
- Online payments
- Tax receipts
- □ Registration

- Student email
- Grades/transcripts
- Parking passes
- Scholarship/bursary applications

Returning Students:

If a student is returning to UFV after stopping for a period of time, they will need to contact <u>OReg</u> or <u>ITS</u> to get their account re-setup.

All registered courses become part of your **permanent academic record.** Not withdrawing from a course you don't plan to complete will bring down your GPA.

Financial Aid & Awards

The **Adult Upgrading Grant** is available to assist with the cost of books, supplies, and other fees to qualifying students. A grant is money given to a student for educational expenses (it does not need to be repaid).

Grant funding is available for students who meet requirements:

- Canadian Citizen, landed immigrant or protected person
- An adult (19+ years of age)
- Attending a post-secondary institution in BC
- Enrolled in Adult Basic Education (ABE), English Language Studies (ELS), or the Workplace TASK program
- Able to demonstrate financial need—proof of income is required



Financial Aid & Awards

Applying for the Adult Upgrading Grant

Applications must be submitted four (4) weeks before the start of the program

- Fill out (type) the AUG form: <u>https://ufv.ca/upgrading/adult-upgrading-grant/</u>
- Sign
- Submit your application and proof of income (see next slide)
- Check your student email on myUFV, for confirmation

*If you receive funding from the Adult Upgrading Grant you need to confirm your eligibility by checking your email (myUFV) or with the Financial Aid office located in Student Services.



Financial Aid & Awards

Adult Upgrading Grant application:

Put your application and copies of ALL documentation into an envelope and:

- Drop off at the Abbotsford campus Financial Aid & Awards drop slot located just past the Student Services doors (B214) below the Student Life info board, OR
- 2. MAIL to the UFV Financial Aid & Awards office:

Note: DO NOT email your application. In the case additional information is required, you will be contacted by phone or email

GET A TIME OVERVIEW

Print or draw up a calendar of the semester's weeks

It is natural for the beginning of the semester to be lighter in content than the end. Adjust your work and social plans accordingly.

MASTER LIST CLASS EXPECTATIONS

Make a list of readings, posting frequency, assignments and tests for each class

Make the list by consulting a grading rubric if available. Itemize what is all needed to get a high mark. You can always adjust your approach if needed for a full schedule at the end of semester if necessary.

PACE YOURSELF

Match up each reading, writing draft, groupwork session, and posting with a time slot

Frequent small work sessions are the most realistic for staying on top of your homework. Try to schedule something specific every day. (ie. read pages 34-38 and take notes, write a 300 word draft, etc)

WORK WITH YOUR WORK STYLE

Consistency is key to success. Take advantage of natural focus times to knock off a few more items.

You can tell when you're on a roll. Use those times to get something extra done, but stop before burnout becomes a concern. As well, don't wait for inspiration to strike. Do your homework as you've scheduled.

TAKE IT ONE DAY AT A TIME

The smaller micro assignments you break your work into, the easier they will be to achieve.

Once you are done your homework for the day, give yourself a reward. Go for a run, walk the dog, make a tea, watch some Netflix. Let tomorrow's homework wait until tomorrow. This is a marathon, not a sprint.

Concerns? Stay calm. Email your instructor. Post a question for your classmates in the discussion board. Have a great semester!




